

## Science & Innovation Lab Materials Help Needed

Thank you Holy Trinity Families for your overwhelming generosity at the beginning and throughout the school year! Your donations have helped our education team bring hands-on science and innovation to our children over the past 12 years. Holy Trinity students participate in over 36 lab sessions per year. (That's approximately 325 opportunities to set up experiments, design and build something, or make observations about our natural and designed world in their K-8 experience!)
